LENT, HOLY WEEK, and EASTER

Lent derives from the centuries-old practice of preparing candidates for Baptism. By the middle of the 4th century in Jerusalem these candidates fasted for 40 days and were taught the basic doctrines of the Church. After it became legal in the Roman Empire to be Christian (313AD), Lent became a general period of preparation of all Christians for Easter. By the 8th century, a Lenten season of 40 days was the standard of the Western Church.

By the fifth century the Church was celebrating the Sunday of the Passion (Palm Sunday), and Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday (the Vigil of Easter), the latter three known in Latin as The Triduum (The Three Days). In the Early Church The Triduum was the holiest season of the entire church year, culminating in the Vigil of Easter, which WAS the Easter service. Imagine Christians in Jerusalem celebrating the Resurrection on the very location of the Empty Tomb.

As you read this we are still in our preparation. In a couple of weeks the Alleluias will burst forth with new life and we will celebrate the entire coming year.

At St. Paul.....We. Will. Celebrate.

Because in Christ we have Health and Hope.

Bethany's SOUP SUPPER CONTEST

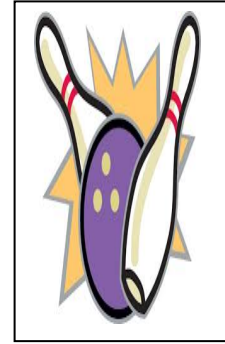
March 11th 4:00 p.m. our soup cook-off contest will be back. Evangelism is hosting
