FROM PASTOR MOORHEAD

Be Prepared! Have you ever heard that before?
Of course, you have. For one thing, it's the motto of the Boy Scouts.
Sometimes I have said, "If you fail to plan, you plan to fail."
Have you ever thought about preparing for Sunday worship?
Maybe most of you are now thinking, "Why would I do that? I'm not a worship leader."
Fair enough. But everyone should prepare for Sunday worship.
The word 'liturgy' (the structure of our worship) come from Greek, *laos ergos*=leitourgia, meaning "work of the people".
So we are not just spectators in the pews. We are engaged in what we are doing.
In fact, I suspect that very often we'll prepare more for being spectators somewhere (like a football game) than we actually prepare for Sunday worship.
So, how do we prepare?
Three ways.
First, decide to attend weekly worship.
Second, pray.
Third, read the Scripture readings for the coming Sunday.
You'll find them in the front of the hymnal, Year A of the three-year lectionary.
Or you'll find them on the liturgical calendars you were given this year, on the back of each monthly page.
It's an exercise (work, preparation) worth your effort.
And very rewarding.
Be prepared!
